## Travelling to Balneden by Public Transport and EV Car-hire

## Train

The Caledonian Sleeper, <u>www.sleeper.scot</u>, operates between London and Inverness, providing you with a very relaxed way to travel − even your dog can accompany you .

For shorter journeys and cheaper options go to <a href="www.scotrail.co.uk">www.splitmyfare.co.uk</a>, or <a href="www.mytrainticket.co.uk">www.mytrainticket.co.uk</a>. Various train companies offer direct trains with connections at Glasgow and Edinburgh.

## **EV Car-hire**

Unfortunately, here at Balneden we are not blessed with any public transport links – the nearest bus stop and cycle hire is in Grantown 13miles away!

There are a number of car-hire companies, however the most eco-friendly company is the family owned and operated <a href="www.focusvehiclerental.co.uk">www.focusvehiclerental.co.uk</a>. Their Eco-friendly Range include various EV hybrid cars, with plans for all electric options coming sometime soon, including 4X4 vehicles (check website for up to date information). 24-hour pick-up points include Inverness and Aviemore train stations, plus Inverness, Aberdeen, Edinburgh and Glasgow Airports (hiring an EV car is a great option if you are concerned about your increased carbon footprint when flying).

## **Electric Charging Points**

We have our own 16/32Amp (3.6/7.2kW) EV charging point which you will be able to use during your stay.

Close by Tomintoul, Grantown and Aviemore also have recharging points. In addition, through <a href="www.chargeplacescotland.org">www.chargeplacescotland.org</a> you can access over 1000 charge points throughout Scotland.
